

Parklands Country Club

CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

Members of Parklands Country Club are bound, as a condition of their membership to comply with the rules and regulations set out under A, B and C. These have been drawn up by the management to ensure that the Leisure Club facilities are properly and safely used, and that all members are able to take advantage of the facilities without interfering with the enjoyment of others.

A. GENERAL

1. DURATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Membership will start on the 1st November each year and end on the 31st October the following year. (Members joining during the year will be liable to pay a proportion of the membership fee for the remaining of the year).

2. FAMILY/SINGLE/BUSINESS/GROUP MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Each member, including children over two years old, will be issued with a membership card. Members will be required to produce their membership cards on each visit in order to obtain entry to the club. Should you not bring your membership card with you the staff of parklands country club have the right to not allow you admittance to the club.

3. ESTABLISHMENT MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Establishment Memberships are for Bona Fide owners of Hotels, Guest Houses and self-catering cottages only. Only one hotel or guesthouse is permitted on a membership card. The membership card will admit 6 people at any one time, who are either staying in the hotel, guest house or self catering cottage or the owners or any immediate family that may be living in the establishment. These membership cards are not for friends and relatives, but purely for the owners, their paying guests and immediate family.

4. OPENING HOURS

The leisure club and sports facilities will be open as follows:

MONDAY TO SUNDAY - 7.30am to 10.15pm

The snooker room will be open until 11.00pm, Monday to Saturday and until 10.30pm on Sunday. The opening times may be subject to alteration, although the management will endeavour to give notice of this.

The management shall be entitled at any time and for any period to vary the times at which the facilities, or any of them, are available, if any of the facilities are required in connection with the general hotel operations of the company, or by reasons of repairs, alterations or maintenance to the leisure centre. Although the management shall be entitled to take such steps without prior notice, the management will seek to notify members in advance by means of a notice board.

5. GUESTS

Members may bring up to 4 guests per day. All guests must be accompanied by the member who must also stay in the leisure centre with the guests during their visit. It is the member's responsibility to ensure that their guests are aware of the rules and conditions of the leisure club and that they comply with them. The guest fee is £5.00 per adult (16 years and over) and £2.50 per child (2 years and over). The member must pay at reception for the extension of their membership to cover their guest's admission to the leisure club.

6. CHILDREN

Children under the age of 12 will not be permitted to the club without a supervising adult (18 years and over), who will supervise them during their stay.

Children under the age of 16 will not be admitted to the pool area without a supervising adult (aged 18 and over)

Children under the age of 16 are not permitted entrance to the trimnasium at any time.

7. LOCKERS

You will need a £1 coin for lockers, which you need to put into the lockers in the changing rooms and will be refunded.

8. DOGS: Dogs with the exception of guide dogs are not permitted in the club.

9. SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the club.

10. CLOTHING

Members and their guests are requested to dress in the manner appropriate to the sporting activity being engaged in.

11. STAFF INSTRUCTIONS

As well as observing the regulations currently applicable to the leisure centre, members and their guests should comply with directions given by the club management and the staff. Members are responsible for ensuring that their guests comply with the rules, regulations and directions.

12. TERMINATIONS

1. Any member misusing the leisure club facilities, or acting in a way in which constitutes a safety hazard or interferes with the enjoyment of the other members will have his/her membership terminated. Moreover, the company reserves the right to terminate any membership at any time, without notice, at its sole discretion. In the event of the membership being terminated, by the company under this regulation, the member concerned will receive a refund of subscription in proportion to the remaining period of their membership.
2. If any member wishes to terminate his/her membership before it would normally expire, then any refund of subscription shall be at the sole discretion of the management. No application for a refund will be considered by the management where the un-expired period of membership is less than two calendar months.
3. If the management considers it necessary to terminate the permission extended to any guest of any member using the leisure facilities no refund of the admission charges will be made.

B FACILITIES

SQUASH: The court can be booked personally by telephoning Windermere 08700 46 86 45. The court is available for bookings from 7.30am to 10.15pm for 45 minutes per session. There is an additional payment for the squash court, which is £2.50 for 45 minutes.

MAIN HALL: All facilities are open from 8.00am to 10pm and are £2.50 per hour to use. Facilities available in the main hall are Badminton, Table Tennis, Indoor bowls and Volley Ball. Bookings can be arranged by telephoning 08700 46 86 45 or by contacting reception.

TRIMNASIUM: (gym) Children under 16 are not permitted in to the trimnasium. The gym is free to use anytime during the day.

SWIMMING POOL: Members are requested to shower before entering the pool. Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Where any health problem exist, a doctor's opinion should be obtained before using the spa, steam room, sauna or pool. Extra rules and regulations can be found on the club notice board.

SNOOKER ROOM: Table A is booked by the hour, booking is done at the bar. The snooker room closes at 11.00pm Monday to Saturday and 10.30pm on Sunday. Children under the age of 16 are not allowed in the bar area or snooker room after 8pm.

SOLARIUM: The sunbed can be booked at reception or by telephone. The charge for sunbed hire is £3.00 for 5 minutes and £6.00 for 10 minutes.

HIRING: Towels are £1.00 to hire, rackets are £1.50, and arm bands are £1.00.

C. LIABILITY

1. Each member and/or guest engaging in activities in the leisure club or making use of the facilities is responsible for ensuring that he/she is properly equipped and that their state of health and physical condition is such that they do not incur any risk to themselves or any other person using the club.
2. While the company makes effort to provide a safe and enjoyable facility and takes its responsibilities under the health and safety at work seriously, members are advised that this is a swimming pool that does not have constant poolside supervision and are therefore advised that the company can accept no liability for accident, injury and misadventure however caused. Members and guests are advised to make their own insurance arrangements in respect of injuries suffered by them or caused by them to any third party.
3. Lockers are provided in the changing rooms for use by members and guests. The management cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to vehicles or property belonging to members or guests. The manager in particular accepts no responsibility for the loss of, or damage to any valuables whilst on the premises (including valuables left in any unattended vehicle).
4. Each member is responsible for making their guests and dependants aware of the leisure club rules and regulations.
